DEED OF EMPLOYEE CONFIDENTIALITY

THIS DEED is made on the date specified in the Schedule

PARTIES:

1. The party identified in the Schedule and hereinafter referred to as **“the Employer”**
2. The party identified in the Schedule and hereinafter referred to as **“the Employee”**

PREAMBLE:

- A. The Employer has or is to employ the Employee in the Employer’s business or company.
- B. The Employee has obtained or will obtain access to certain confidential information in the course of its employment and has agreed to protect the confidentiality of such information in accordance with this Deed.

IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 In this Deed the following definitions apply unless the context otherwise requires:

“Confidential Information” means information that is by its nature confidential or is designated by the Employer as confidential and without limiting the generality of the foregoing includes information:

- (a) Comprised in or relating to any intellectual property rights of the Employer or its clients;
- (b) Relating to the financial position of the Employer or its clients or to any matter that does or may affect the financial position or reputation of the Employer or its clients;
- (c) Relating to the personnel of the Employer or its clients;
- (d) Relating to the commercial or product strategies of the Employer or its clients;
